With the increased amount of traffic through the grounds as well as the popularity of the surrounding Kilcornan area for walks we would like to remind everyone of a few simple rules to ensure the safety of pedestrians, cyclists and motorists.



- Wear a <u>high-vis vest</u> when walking in Kilcornan woods & the Colga grounds - high vis vests are easier to see and less confusing for drivers than torches
- Walk against the direction of traffic so the driver can see you and you can see them
- Do not drop players at the gates to walk to the astro unless they are wearing high-vis garments
- Please reduce your speed when driving through the grounds and Kilcornan New Club Sponsor
